

## TRADITIONS (continued)

7. Every OA group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.  
SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLE – RESPONSIBILITY

8. Overeaters Anonymous should remain forever nonprofessional, but our service centers may employ special workers.  
SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLE – FELLOWSHIP

9. OA, as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.  
SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLE – STRUCTURE

10. Overeaters Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the OA name ought never be drawn into public controversy.  
SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLE - NEUTRALITY

11. Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio, films, television, and other public media of communication.  
SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLE – ANONYMITY

12. Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all these Traditions, every reminding us to place principles before personalities.
